

MeDMUN Rules on Observer Countries

Some committees have observer members who are not normally represented in the committee, but offer an important perspective that is necessary for the topics to run more effectively.

At our Conferences Observer Members **can**:

1. Make and Vote on procedural motions
 - a. Procedural motions include:
 - i. Opening the Speaker's List;
 - ii. Opening/Closing Debate;
 - iii. Limiting Speaking Time;
 - iv. Unmoderated/Moderated Caucuses
 1. Extension of Unmoderated Caucuses
 - v. Bringing a Resolution or Amendment to the Floor
2. Give speeches from:
 - a. The Speaker's List
 - b. During an Unmoderated Caucus
 - c. During a Moderated Caucus
3. Ask Questions when a delegate yields to Q&A
4. Write Resolutions and Amendments with other countries

At our Conferences Observer Members **cannot**:

1. Vote on resolutions and amendments in voting procedure
2. Vote on dividing the question in voting procedure
